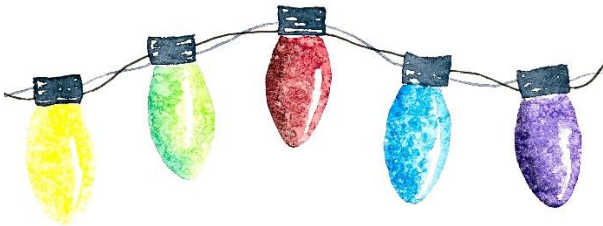

### **Beginning Drawing**

### **Watercolor**

**Fee:** \$192/8wks

Experience the exciting medium of watercolor as you develop composition in line, shape, color, texture, and value. Skills in grid drawing, spatial relationships, and use of light and shadow will be covered. Class will include experimenting with projects along with emphasis on critique and development of personal style. All levels welcome. Supply list discussed in first class.

**Drawing with Value & Color****Ages:** 15yrs-Adult**Online:** Tuesdays, 10/27 thru 12/15, 6:30-7:30pm**Instructor:** Brian Jacobs**Fee:** \$96/8wks

Develop your skills in drawing, design and composition as you draw from still life arrangements and photographs. Engage with practice exercises and develop finished studies using graphite, color pencils, and other drawing media. Intermediate students welcome.

**Online Supply List:** Graphite drawing pencils from HB to 6B, white eraser, drawing or mixed media paper, and color drawing media of choice—art crayons, colored pencils, pastel pencils, chalk pastels, or oil pastels.

Optional supplies will be shared during first class.

**Acrylic Still Life Basics****Ages:** Adult**Online:** Monday, 11/2 thru 12/21, 6:30-8pm**Instructor:** Tara Seibel**Fee:** \$144/8wks

Develop your skills in drawing a still-life composition. Then turning that composition into an acrylic painting! We will observe 3-D still-life arrangements and photographs. As an exercise we will try and copy an arrangement done by a master. Beginner and Intermediate levels welcome.

**Online Supply List:** #2 & #4 pencils, kneaded eraser, sketch paper, Bristol board, canvas, colored pencils (for studies) acrylic paints, small/medium flat and round paint brushes for acrylics

**Oil Painting****Ages:** 15yrs-Adult**Online:** Thursdays 10/22 thru 12/10 (no 11/26), 1:30-2:30pm**Instructor:** Linda Merchant Pearce**Fee:** \$168/7wks

The traditional medium of oils gives a translucency and versatility to artwork like no other. Learn how to use oil paints without solvents as you develop layers which allows for a sense of realism in light and form. Intermediate through advanced levels welcome. Some art experience recommended. This class is taught via a series of YouTube videos and Zoom meetings with the instructor.

**Online Supply List:** (Recommended, not required) Ampersand Gessobord, Stretched Canvas, canvas boards, or other painting surface, Easel, References that you would like to paint, objects for still life, Oil paint, Synthetic or natural hair brushes for oil paint, Artist Grade Walnut oil or Linseed oil, Brush cleaner, palette or waxed paper plate.

**Watercolor****Ages:** 15 yrs-Adult**Online:** Thursday, 10/23 thru 12/11 (no 11/27), 3-4pm**Instructor:** Linda Merchant Pearce**Fee:** \$137/7wks

Experience the exciting medium of watercolor as you develop composition in line, shape, color, texture, and value. **Online Supply List:** Watercolors - either tubed or in a watercolor palette. If using tubed watercolors, an empty watercolor palette, jar for water, variety of brush sizes, watercolor paper or block (Arches Aquarelle or similar is good), If using single sheet watercolor paper, I suggest having a hard drawing board to tape or staple your paper to, pencil for sketching your drawings, eraser, ruler, frisket/drawing gum, kosher salt

**Studio Ceramics****Ages:** Adult**On-site:** Thursdays 10/22 thru 12/10 (no 11/26), 10am-12:30pm or 6-8:30pm**Instructor:** Brigitte Fiorille**Fee:** \$227/7wks

Students in this class are supported to develop independent focus and direction of work. Technique demonstration and projects are offered to learn and explore the process of ceramics. "New to clay" students will be guided through a beginning curriculum of projects. Kick and electric wheels available. Raku firing will be scheduled as a separate event. All levels welcome.
