Watercolor (5 weeks)

Class will include experimenting with projects along with emphasis on critique and development of personal style. All levels welcome. Supply list discussed in first class.

Oil Painting (6 weeks)

The traditional medium of oils gives a translucency and versatility to artwork like no other. Learn how to use oil paints without solvents as you develop layers which allows for a sense of realism in light and form. Intermediate through advanced levels welcome. Some art experience recommended. This class is taught via a series of YouTube videos and Zoom meetings with the instructor.

Online Supply List: (Recommended) Ampersand Gessobord, Stretched Canvas, canvas boards, or other painting surface, Easel, References that you would like to paint, objects for still life, Oil paint, Synthetic or natural hair brushes, Artist Grade Walnut oil or Linseed oil, Brush cleaner, palette or waxed paper plate.

Watercolor (6 weeks)

Online Supply List: Watercolors - either tubed or in a watercolor palette. If using tube watercolors, an empty watercolor palette, jar for water, variety of brush sizes, watercolor paper or block (Arches Aquarelle or similar is good), If using single sheet watercolor paper, I suggest having a hard drawing board to tape or staple your paper to, pencil for sketching your drawings, eraser, ruler, frisket/drawing gum, kosher salt

Ceramic Arts

Creation in Coil (3 weeks)

Age: 8-12yrs

On-site: Tuesday, 6/15-7/29, 4:30-6pm

Fee: \$59

Roll & stack coils into creative and unique vessels. Several pieces will be developed in the first two classes and glazed in the last class. Pieces will be available for pick up following classes.

Wheel Throwing (3 weeks)

Age: 10-14yrs

On-site: Tuesday, 7/6 thru 7/20, 4:30-6:30pm

Instructor: Brigitte Fiorille

Fee: \$78

Learn the basics of wheel throwing with kick and electric wheels. Time is allotted for throwing (first two weeks) along with trimming and underglazing. Pieces will be available for pick up following classes.

Stenciled Ceramic Tiles (1 week)

Age: 15yrs to Adult

On-site: Monday, 6/28, 6-8:30pm

Instructor: Brigitte Fiorille

Fee: \$33

Use stencilling techniques to design a series of ceramic tiles. Individual tiles can become works of art as individuals, mosaics, or as hangings. Collective size of pieces in approx. 12"x12" space. Tiles will be made using stoneware clay with colored slips and clear glaze.

Studio Ceramics (6 weeks)

Ages: 15yrs to Adult

On-site: Thursday, 6/17 thru 7/22, 10am-12:30pm or 3-5:30pm or 6-8:30pm

Instructor: Brigitte Fiorille

Fee: \$195/6wks

Students in this class are supported to develop independent focus and direction of work. Technique demonstration and projects are offered to learn and explore the process of ceramics. "New to clay" students will be guided through a beginning curriculum of projects. Kick and electric wheels available. Raku firings weather permitting. Tuesday eve open studio (independent work) available to current students with additional fee. All levels welcome.
