



Summer of MUSIC!

Love music? Fairmount Center for the Arts offers customized, one-on-one private lessons in flute, voice, piano, violin, viola, guitar, ukulele and saxophone. Lessons are designed for children ages 5 years old and up (age varies by instrument), and are offered for novice through advanced players.

Priority for Current Fairmount Students:

Current music students have priority registration for the next session. Spring 2021 students have through Friday, May 21 to register for the Summer session and retain their current day/time (if applicable/available with the current instructor). As of Monday May 24, studio schedules are open to new registrations. For the Fall 2021 session, Spring 2021 students have through Friday, August 6 to register and retain their current day/time (if applicable/available with the current instructor). As of Monday August 9, studio schedules are open to new registrations. Payment for Music Lessons:

Payment is due at the time of registration and may be made via credit card, check, or cash. A payment plan is available if needed. Make-up lessons for student absences are at the discretion of the instructor and are not required. Notification of inability to attend a lesson is a courtesy to the instructor and may be communicated directly to the instructor or to Fairmount at (440) 338-3171. Make-up lessons for FCA or Instructor cancellations will be scheduled within the makeup week or per instructor.

Music Lesson Tuition: 6-week session: \$150 (\$25 per ½ hour lesson). Music lessons are typically scheduled in ½ hour increments.

Kearns is also a member of the Canton Symphony Orchestra and substitutes with the Akron Symphony and the Erie Philharmonic.
