

Fairmount Center for the Arts - ONSITE PROGRAM PROCEDURES

Fairmount has been working hard to ensure the safety of the Fairmount community. Please review the policies below, as they are continuously updated.

Procedures for Attending Programs at Fairmount Center for the Arts (FCA)

By registering for a program at Fairmount Center for the Arts (either for myself or as parent/guardian of a child), I agree to the following:

Protection of Self and Others from Possible Exposure

Before coming to FCA I will perform a health assessment on myself (or on my child) consisting of the following symptoms: ● Temperature is less than 100.4 degrees ● Free of a persistent cough ● Free from any of these symptoms: muscle pain and/or chills; shortness of breath/difficulty breathing; a recent loss of smell and/or taste; or unusual digestive issues (i.e. diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting).

If I am experiencing any of the above symptoms, I will not go to FCA or send my child to FCA.

If I am confirmed positive with COVID -19, I will inform the Executive Director and I will begin quarantining for 10-14 days.

Face Mask/Covering Requirements

Students and staff at FCA are **NOT** required to wear a face mask or covering if they fit one of the following criteria:

- The student/staff member is fully vaccinated (14 days after their second dose of a Moderna or Pfizer vaccine OR 14 days after a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine)
 - Students/staff **MUST** provide proof of vaccination to Fairmount to forgo mask-wearing. Proof of vaccination will **NOT** be kept on file at Fairmount.
- The student/staff member is **OUTDOORS** and socially distanced from others by at least 3 feet, per CDC guidelines
- A student is age 5 or under
- A student/staff member is in a room/studio **BY THEMSELVES**

All students/staff members who are **NOT** fully vaccinated (or have yet to provide proof of vaccination), or students between the ages of 6-12 (who are not yet eligible for vaccination) will be required to wear face masks/coverings indoors at all times while at FCA at this time. If they are outdoors at any point, masks can be removed as per the guideline listed above regarding outdoor mask-wearing.

Hand Washing Upon entering FCA

I will use hand sanitizer or wash my hands with soap and water for 20 seconds.

I will wash my hands with soap and water for 20 seconds after toileting.

Social Distancing

I will not arrive at FCA more than ten minutes prior to the start of my class.

I will not linger in the building to socialize after class.

I will respect the markings on the floors and in program areas that denote appropriate social distancing.

As a parent or guardian, I will limit my time in the building to include only drop off and pick up. For children under 10 years of age*, staff will help with entrance, delivery to class, and exit at the door. (*Exception: a class designed for adult and child to attend together).

The protocols are subject to change depending on the current guidelines of the State of Ohio.
