About the Role

We are seeking part-time Dance Faculty to teach during our Fall, Spring, and Summer Programs. Hours vary depending on our Program Schedules - may include afternoons, evenings, daytime hours, and subbing opportunities throughout each session.

You'll plan + facilitate lessons for assigned classes, create choreography for performances, and provide support for Dance Program Events as needed. Knowledge of classroom management techniques, consistent communication, and creating a positive classroom environment that supports student success is essential to this position.

Responsibilities:

- Create and facilitate lessons + choreography for assigned classes
- Coordinate with Director of Dance to ensure class materials are aligned with Dance Program Curriculum
- Utilize sound pedagogy and age appropriate content, materials, and assessment methods
- Communicate with Director of Dance to address Student and Parent questions and concerns, including Student Evaluations + Placement Recommendations
- Communicate + distribute Dance Program information to assigned classes as needed
- Collaborate with Director of Dance + Dance Faculty to maintain safe, clean studio spaces
- Support Dance Program Performances + Events as needed
- Attend Dance Program meetings as needed
