Our Music program currently offers private and small-group instruction in Violin, Viola, Piano, Guitar, Saxophone, Ukulele, and Voice.

About the Music Faculty Position

Music faculty will plan and facilitate private or group lessons and be present at the end-of-session recitals. Knowledge of classroom management techniques, consistent communication, and creating a positive classroom environment that supports student success is essential to this position.

Part-time music faculty teach during our fall, spring, and summer programs. Hours vary depending on our program schedules and student needs, ranging from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., Monday through Friday and Saturday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

We are particularly interested in candidates who can teach daytime hours for our camps and outreach programming during the week as well as those interested in offering group music instruction. Classes may be held in-person or virtually.

We are also specifically looking for instructors in **piano, violin, guitar, and wind instruments** (oboe, saxophone).

Responsibilities:

- Create and facilitate private/one-on-one music lessons for assigned students and / or group classes

- Coordinate with the Director of Operations to confirm student and class schedules and address student and parent questions or concerns.
- Utilize sound pedagogy and age appropriate content, materials, and assessment methods.
- Attend end-of-session music recitals (December and May).
- Attend music faculty meetings and training sessions as required.

- Education, training, and experience in music education and/or performance in your area of specialization
- Experience working with a wide range of ages and abilities.
- Teaching experience in the area of music / your area of specialization
- Ability to teach more than one age group or instrument a plus
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
